

FILM RAVE 2014

REGULATIONS OF PARTICIPATION IN THE FILM WORKSHOP

§1

1. The FILM RAVE film workshop (edition 2014) hereinafter referred to as the Workshop will take place from 31.03 until 05.04.2014 in Poznań.
2. The Workshop is an associated event of the 6th edition of Short Waves Festival, which takes place from 30.03 until 06.04.2014.
3. The official language of the Workshop is English.

§2

The Workshop is an open film and educational event. The rules of participation in the Workshop are stated solely in these Regulations. All the promotional and advertising materials are only of informational nature.

§3

The aim of the Workshop is:

- a. Film education of the young people from the European countries;
- b. Popularization of film education as a method of dissemination of culture among the young people from Europe;
- c. Improving the abilities of the young people from the European countries in the field of film art ;
- d. Supporting the development of cinema;
- e. Promoting the city of Poznań by means of initiating innovative artistic and cultural actions.

§4

All the propriety copyrights to the form of the Workshop are held by the Foundation of Cultural Education Ad Arte, hereinafter referred to as the Organizer.

§5

1. In order to supervise the content-related and organizational matters related to the Workshop completion the Organizer appoints the Organization Team whose actions will be overseen by the Workshop Coordinator-Weronika Drzewińska.
2. The Workshop Coordinator, who is appointed by the Organizer and who is granted with a casting vote in all the points of dispute that have not been mentioned in the regulations or require further interpretation, is responsible for all the matters related to preparation of the Workshop and its course.
3. In case of a transient obstacle in the process of making urgent decisions such decisions are taken by an absolute majority of votes of the Organization Team in the presence of at least half of its members in open voting.

§6

The Organizer asks for cooperation other entities, including governmental, non-governmental and commercial organizations, whose aim is to make a contribution in kind or financial contribution into preparation and completion of the Workshop.

§7

To all matters not settled herein provisions of the civil code, Copyright and Neighbouring Rights Act and all the generally applicable legal regulations shall apply.

§8

1. Each person from the age of 18 years old up to 30 years old (hereinafter referred to as the Participant) who is a citizen of: Albania, Austria, Bulgaria, Croatia, Czech Republic, Denmark, Estonia, Finland, France, Germany, Greece, Italy, Kosovo, Lithuania, Luxembourg, Macedonia, Montenegro, Netherlands, Norway, Poland, Portugal, Russia, Spain, Ukraine, the United Kingdom; and who has provided the Organizer with a completed Application Form (available on www.shortwaves.pl) may apply for participation in the Workshop.
2. The aim of the Workshop is completion of short fiction films inspired by the theme of the 6th edition of the Short Waves Festival entitled *Nothing is the same*.
3. While completing the films the Participants will work in teams consisting of 5 people. Each Participant will have their function: a director, a cameraman, a sound designer, a film editor or a unit production manager.
4. The number of places is limited.

§9

§10

The Organizer reserves the right to extend the period of admissions in the case when an insufficient number of applications is received until the date mentioned in §9

§11

The Organizer shall not be liable for the Application Forms that have not been received or have been received with delay due to reasons beyond the Organizer's control.

§12

The Participant is fully liable for accuracy and correctness of the data in the Application Form. Providing false, illegible or incomplete personal data or not providing them at all results in exclusion from participation in the Workshop.

§13

The Participants will be informed about the admission by means of a written confirmation from the Organizer sent within 7 days from the termination of the admission process. The recruitment process will be conducted by the Organization Team on the basis of the completed Application Form. Information about the results of the recruitment process will also be published on www.shortwaves.pl within 7 days from the termination of the admission process.

§14

1. The registration fee for participation in the Workshop is 100 euros or 400 zł (gross) and guarantees participation in all the events that are a part of the programme as well as accommodation from 30 March until 06 April 2014.

If the registration fee is not be paid into the aforementioned bank account by 15.03.2014, the Participant will be crossed off the list of participants. The Organizers will not return the registration fee.

§16

The Organizers reimburses 50% of the travel expenses (from and to Poznań) in the maximum amount of 200 euros. Reimbursement takes place once each of the Participants has filled in a document entitled "Reimbursement form" and has presented tickets and proofs of purchase.

§17

Applying for participation in the Workshop equals to one's unconditional agreement to provisions of these Regulations.

§18

The Participant has the right and obligation to take part in all the activities (lectures, practical exercises and accompanying events) provided in the Workshop's programme.

§19

The Participant gives consent to promote the effects of their artistic activity completed under the Workshop by means of presenting a portfolio, a jingle or any other creative audiovisual work (including the whole film completed under the Workshop) promoting the mission and aims of the Workshop in television and radio stations as well as the Internet.

§20

The Participant hereby allows their personal data to be processed and presented for the needs of the recruitment process and participation in the Workshop in accordance with the Personal Data Protection Act dated 29.08.1997 (Journal of Laws of the Republic of Poland No 133, item 833).
